We're teaming up with Cash for College to help foster youth complete FAFSA!

Each year, thousands of dollars are left on the table when students don't complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This application can be intimidating for students, especially foster youth. Yet, it is needed to access federal Pell Grants, state Cal Grants, and foster youth Chafee grants, which can make all the difference in whether youth are able to pay for college and stay in college.

The Independent Living Program at DCFS is teaming up with Cash for College to help L.A. County foster youth complete FAFSA by the March 2nd priority deadline. Staff with experience serving foster youth and trained volunteers will be on hand at the below Cash for College workshops to help youth navigate FAFSA, CA Dream Act, and Chafee Grant application forms. Foster youth will also learn about other campus and community resources available to support them in their college journeys.
