CONNECT LA - YOUTH FAMILY RECONNECTION PROGRAM

The Youth Family Reconnection Program is designed to reconnect Transitional Age Youth (TAY) with family and/or building/strengthening positive relationships with adults. The YFR program is a form of family intervention intended to support youth who desire to reconnect and strengthen their relationship with family or other supportive adults. The Youth Family Reconnection Program supports youth and families through a tailored package of assistance which may include conflict resolution, individual/family counselling and problem-solving strategies. The fundamental goal of family reconnection is to reduce the amount time a young person experiences homelessness by connecting them back to family or linking youth to community resources that enable them to achieve housing stability with family support.

How to Qualify

- ✓ Age 16-24
- ✓ Must be experiencing homelessness or at risk
- ✓ Have interest in reconnecting with family or other adult
