UCLA Bruin Weekend 2010

July 23-25, 2010 (Friday-Sunday)

About the program

The UCLA Bruin Weekend is a FREE 3-day intensive summer program. Designed to provide rising 10th graders (current 9th graders) with the academic support and enrichment needed to assist them in becoming competitive applicants within the UC system. This program provides grade appropriate information regarding higher education and presents students with a preview to the collegiate experience. The core program format consists of group workshops (writing, a-g requirements, and small group discussions), presentations and campus tours. Students accepted to the program have an opportunity to live in the UCLA residence halls, giving students the full UCLA campus experience.

- Students will leave with a thorough understanding of the college application process
- Students will leave understanding how their attitudes and choices affect their choices.
- Students will learn what it takes to become a competitive applicant for a selective institution such as UCLA.
- Students will have a chance to interact with current UCLA undergraduates.
- Students will meet with an Admissions officer in order to develop an academic plan.

Eligibility Criteria

- Be a rising 10th grader (current 9th grader)
- Have at least a 2.8 unweighted GPA
- Completed 2-3 College prep courses (a-g) with grades C or better preferably in Algebra 1 or Geometry, English, and one other a-g course.
- Submit a completed application with copy of unofficial transcript attached
- Participate in all 3 days of the program
