Make sure to get your Medi-Cal coverage extended once you turn 18 so it covers you until you're 21. Get reimbursed by the Youth Development Services Division for health expenses not covered by Medi-Cal. Check this out and stay healthy

The Health Care Rights of Children in Foster Care

Free Healthcare Services from Young & Healthy

The Pasadena Alumni Support Center (PASC) and the Young & Healthy Program provide transportation and medical, dental and mental health care from a roster of practices that offer free services to transitioning youth in the Pasadena area. If you need medical, dental or mental health services not covered by Medi-Cal, contact [PASC](#) and ask for a referral to the Young & Healthy program.

Social Security Disability Income (SSDI) and Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

Recipients of SSDI and SSI benefits from the [Social Security Administration](#) are also eligible to receive Youth Development Services benefits if they qualify as ILP eligible youth, have an unmet need and funding is available.

Can I See my Health Records?

Yes. It is required that all court reports be sent to all youth ages 10 and over. The Health and Education Passport (HEP) Binder in its entirety (includes the binder and all contents) is to be given to you once you exit the foster care system. Welfare and Institutions Code Section 16010 mandates that the Case Plan for every child in foster care includes a summary of the child's health and education information and that a copy of the summary be attached to all court reports.
