## **Dr. L. Benjamin Livingston**

- “Big Ben,” “Gentle Ben,” father, husband, golfer, musician, psychologist, businessman, consultant, professor, and fraternity brother. Loveless Benjamin Livingston was born in Eufaula, Oklahoma on July 1, 1931, one of eleven children.
- He attended Langston University in Oklahoma and pledged Omega Psi Phi (Phi Psi Chapter). Ben earned a BA in Management from the University of Arizona; and a Masters and a PhD in Psychology from Arizona State University (ASU).
- Ben moved to Riverside and joined the UC Riverside faculty as a professor and counselor. Ben's life was consumed with family, fraternity, community service and golf.
- He was a life member of the NAACP and served as 2<sup>nd</sup> vice president and, as a member of their Executive Board. He also served the community as a Board Member for the Urban League, Life Member of the Musical National Conference, member of the Phi Delta Kappa honorary society, dedicated member of Toastmasters, Optimists International, and a host of other political and community service related organizations.
- In the fraternity, Brother Livingston was recognized as National Omega Man of The Year in 1977-79 and was elected First Vice Grand Basileus of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity. In 1979, Benjamin Livingston was elected Grand Basileus (National President).
- Brother Ben Livingston was a confidant and husband to his wife, Margaret; a compass and father to his three sons; a guiding light and brother to our fraternity; and a friend and valuable contributor to the Inland Empire community.
