

HALO Citation Clinic

What is it?

The HALO Citation Clinic offers eligible individuals the chance to clear up a failure to appear ticket in exchange for 4 hours of community obligation work with an approved service provider.

The community obligation work can be general labor, office work, job related training, life skills classes, AA or NA meetings, anger management training, mental health counseling or other approved activities.

Who is eligible?

To be eligible, a person must be homeless, live in subsidized housing, receive public assistance and/or suffer from a disability including issues of mental health, substance abuse or addiction.

What tickets are eligible?

- Tickets issued to an adult
- Ticket must be set in a court within the City of Los Angeles.
- Tickets with a missed court date.
- Tickets where a failure to appear has been issued.
- Tickets for pedestrian violations (i.e. fare evasion, jaywalking, open container of alcohol in public, blocking the sidewalk, littering, shopping cart possession).
- No moving violations (cited while driving a vehicle)
- No parking tickets.
- No open or pending cases.
- No cases that have been sent to collections.
