No specific education level or prior art handling experience is required, just a strong interest in physical work. The program aims to provide opportunities to groups systemically marginalized and underrepresented in the professional art handling field. This includes Black, Indigenous, and people of color, women, LGBTQIA, the gender 38 community. Those formerly incarcerated or systemically impacted, immigrants, and foster youth. While the apprenticeship prioritizes individuals from underrepresented backgrounds, all eligible candidates are welcome to apply.
